fleshly power vs. spiritual power vs 1 remember the meekness of Jesus can one be meek and bold at the same time? vs 1 you mistake meekness for timidity vs 10 letters powerful but person and speech lousy vs 2a if needful I will show how forceful I can be vs 2b some of you think I operate in the flesh "some" vs 11 "let such a person" vs 3 I do not use fleshly tools like your super leaders vss 4-5 destruction of fortresses happens in the Spirit vs 5 "lofty thing" = dig at super leaders vs 6 "disobedience" reinforces speaking of leaders vss 7-16 judging by appearances vs 7 you are looking at things as they are outwardly "outwardly" = Grk "before your face" II Cor 5:16 we see souls, not men vs 7 to you I appear powerless, but like you I too am Christ's vs 8-11 I have authority from God to act the same way I write vs 11 you who think I am all show and no go, watch out! vs 12 I won't compete with other, bragful leaders power-tripping, foolishness vs 13 God has given me the important kind of influence and it worked in your case vs 14 didn't I bring you the gospel? vs 15 unlike your hero leaders, I don't take credit anoth work I hope to do yet more in you vs 16 afterward, I will move on to fresh fields
