Acts 7 Steven's stoning

Acts 8 Paul's consuming hatred

vs 1 "and Saul approved of his execution"

vs 3 "Saul was ravaging the church"

Acts 9 Paul's conversion

vss 8-9 "Paul saw nothing and ate nothing for three days"

vs 13 "But Lord, I have heard..."

vs 18 "Paul was baptized"

Acts 9 Paul begins preaching

vs 20 "He is the Son of God"

vs 22 "he increased in strength and confounded the Jews"

Acts 9 Paul's disciples secret him out in a basket at night

Acts 9 Paul shows up in Jerusalem and scares Jesus' disciples

vs 26 "they did not believe he was a disciple"

Acts 9 first death threat, Paul sent away for his safety by apostles

[Acts 10-12 Peter's story]

Acts 13-14: 1st missionary journey: Syria, Greece, Asia Minor

vs 2, 4 Holy Spirit sends Saul out

Acts 13 Paul in Cyprus, Elymas the magician made blind

Acts 13 Paul preaches at Antioch (Syria), after commits to Gentiles

vs 44 "almost the whole city" turns out

Acts 14 Paul at Iconium, flees to Lystra

Acts 14 Paul heals at Lystra, encounters priest of Zeus

Acts 14 Paul's stoning at Lystra

vs 21 after which Paul "made many disciples"

Acts 14 Paul goes back to Antioch

Acts 15 Paul debates circum with Jerusalem brethr (Peter speaks)

vs 10 "yoke neither our fathers nor we have been able to bear"

Acts 15 Paul part of delegation to Antioch re Gentiles/circumcision

Acts 15 Paul has falling out with Mark

Acts 15-18: 2nd missionary journey: Syria, Greece

Acts 16 Paul meets Timothy

Acts 16 Lydia believes in Philippi

Acts 16 Paul ministers to servant girl, beaten, imprisoned as result

Acts 16 Philippian jailor believes

Acts 17 Paul reaches Thessalonica, preaches, many believe, mob

Acts 17 Paul reaches Berea

Acts 17 Paul escapes to Athens, preaches on Mars hill

Acts 18 Paul reaches Corinth, meets Aquila and Priscilla, preaches

Acts 18 Paul opposed and again turns Gentiles, many believe

Acts 18 Sosthenes gets brunt of upheaval

Acts 18-21: 3rd missionary journey: Syria, Greece, Jerusalem

Acts 18 Paul goes to Ephesus then Antioch

Acts 19 Paul again in Ephesus, preaching in synagogues

vs 10 "all of Asia heard the word of the Lord"

Acts 19 comment re handkerchiefs

Acts 19 spiritists give up their practices

Acts 19 riot in Ephesus re silver statues

Acts 20 Paul avoids another death threat in Greece

Acts 20 Paul raises dead boy

Acts 20 Paul's weeping departure

Acts 21 Paul in Jerusalem, convinces James not dising Judaism

Acts 21 Paul arrested due to critics

Acts 21-22 Paul's sermon

Acts 22 Paul avoids a whipping

Acts 23 Jesus tells Paul to go to Rome

Acts 23 Paul's nephew helps him escape another death plot

Acts 23-24 Paul before Felix

Acts 25 yet another death plot averted

Acts 25 Festus sends Paul to Caesar, sees King Agrippa first

Acts 25-26 Paul before King Agrippa

vs 24 "Paul, your great learning is making you crazy!"

vs 28 "you're about to turn me in a Christian!"

vs 32 "he could have gone free if he hadn't appealed to Caesar"

Acts 27-28: 4th missionary journey: Rome

Acts 27 Paul shipwrecks on way to Rome

Acts 28 Paul and the viper, heals Malta governor

Acts 28 Paul in Rome, preaches two years while under house arrest
