vs 6

“the new covenant”

Lk 22:19-20 *“poured out for you is the new covenant in My blood”*

“new testament” from Latin = (AD170) Tertullian and contemporaries

the covenants

Abrahamic Gen 12:1-3

Mosaic Ex 24:3-8

Davidic II Sam 7:1-16

New Lk 22:14-20; Jer 31:31-33

some people insert Adamic and Noahic

Jer 31:31-33 *“the day is coming”*

Heb = *“better”* >30x

Heb 8:6, 7, 13 *“obsolete”*

Heb 10:39 *“not shrink back”*

Heb 10:32-35 *“suffering”*

Heb 3:14; 4:14 *“hold fast”*

Heb 6:9 all the way to salvation

powerless

Heb 7:18, 19, 22; 10:1 *“not perfect”*

Heb 8:7 *“faulty”*

Heb 7:22-24 *“inferior mediator”*

II Cor 3:13 *“inferior duration”*

provisionary

Heb 13:20 *“eternal covenant”*

Gal 3:18-21 *“until the Seed came”*

progressive

Jer 31:32 *“not like I made”*

Heb 1:1 *“portions”* ESV *“times”*

letter vs. Spirit

Gal life not available in the Law

Rom 8:3 the Law left flesh, flesh

Rom 8:11 the Law did not empower

Acts 15:10 *“a yoke our fathers couldn’t bear”*

II Cor 3:17 entrapped, bound

vss 8-9 *“death, condemnation”*

vss 7, 11

analogy of Moses’ fading glory

vss 10-11 no comparison

vs 11 *“remains”* = permanent
