# 4:7-5:10 **READ**

### vss 6-7

"this shined-in light is housed in clay pots" 2:16 "who is adequate?"

### vss 8-9

merciful affliction "but not" ff unfading glory mercy and glory overshadow our affliction Rom 8:18 "not worthy to be compared"

#### vss 10-12

Jesus' death and resurrection displayed in us His death evident results in His life being recognized

#### vs 13

"we preach because we believe" Ps 116:10 LXX despite suffering vs 1; I Cor 4:8-13

#### vs 14

eternity awaits we'll join you in heaven

#### vs 15

all who believe will be there to praise Him

#### vs 16

"though death is evident in our bodies, inside we are more and more new"

#### vs 17

*"glory beyond all comparison"* Rom 8:18 *"not worthy to be compared"* 

#### vs 18

the physical is less important than the eternal our eyes are fixed on the eternal 5:7 *"we walk by faith, not by sight"*  5:1

death just changes the temporary to the eternal

vs 2

"we wearily yearn to get there" "groan" vs 4 "groan"

# vs 3

"we shall have new bodies"

# vss 4, 8-10

we want desparately to have them that the temporary will no longer exist vs 8 we are ready to go vs 9 but our job here is to live for Him vs 10 "what is done in this body we will account for"

# vs 5

this is in God's plan; He gave as a 'down payment' the Holy Spirit

# vss 6-7

we hang on in hope, though we want to go vs 7 *"we walk by faith, not by sight"* 

# vs 10

what is done in these clay pots "we will account for"
